## BLOOD DRIVE FILLS COMMUNITY NEEDS

Camp meeting attendees will partner with the Red Cross at the Bloodmobile at the campground for the 17th year, since 2004.

Before COVID, we had approximately 100 people donate blood during camp meeting each year. But this year, only about 35-40 people will be able to donate blood during the two-day drive. According to Tori Michelson of the Red Cross, this is due to increased space requirements in the bus.

Michelson says there is an especially urgent need during the summer months for blood donations. Nice weather tends to produce a large number of “no-shows” to appointments

and they are having a very hard time meeting the local need for blood. Another factor since the pandemic, has been the high rate of cancellations due to illness.

Precautions are taken at each appointment to make sure each donor is free of illness including COVID-19. Donors must be symptom free, not testing positive to the illness and have been well for at least two weeks prior to donating blood. Masks are required inside the bloodmobile and temperatures are taken before the draw.

This year, the Bloodmobile will be onsite Thursday and Friday from 11AM to 4PM. Currently, the donation appointment time slots are filled for both days. However, anyone who is not scheduled can stop by to see if they have time to fit an extra person in between appointments.
