KidCheck
SECURE CHILDREN'S CHECK-IN

THE GOOD NEWS: We're doing everything we can to make sure your child stays safe - that's why we're using KidCheck to check-in your child at camp meeting.

KidCheck is an online system that helps us keep track of children ages 0-10; it also helps us make sure your child gets the help they need in case of an emergency.

THE NOT-SO-GOOD NEWS: While it doesn't take long to register with KidCheck, this is probably not something you want to do just before you drop-off your child at a meeting!

That's why we're asking *all* parents and guardians to set up their free KidCheck account just as soon as they can.

THE GOOD NEWS: It's easy to set up your free KidCheck account on your computer or your phone.

- On your computer: go to go.kidcheck.com and select "Create Your Kidcheck Account."
- On your phone: download the free KidCheck mobile app from the Apple App Store, or from the Google Play Store.

THE GREAT NEWS: Once you've registered your child with KidCheck, you won't need to do this again! Just bring your child to each meeting - and every time you do, input your phone number, tap the green "submit" button on your phone app, pick up your receipt and a name-tag for your child, and you're done!

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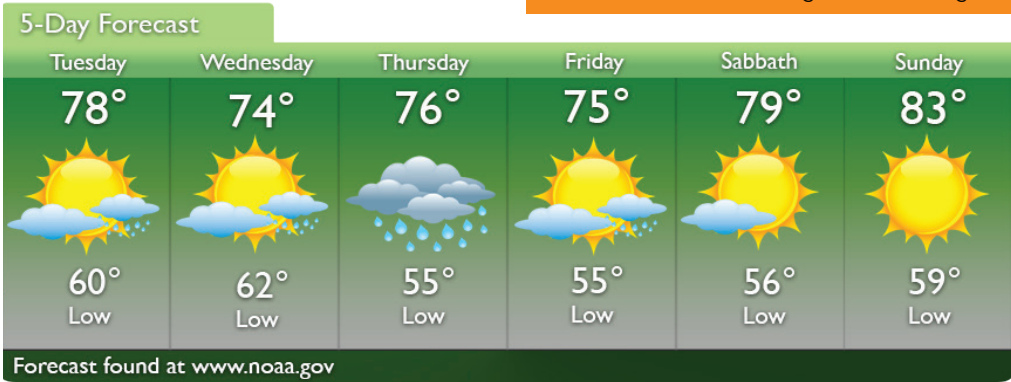
