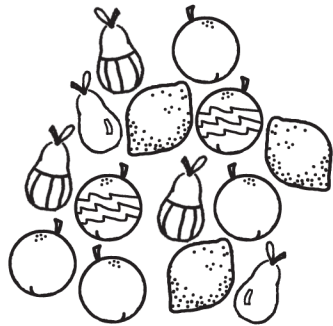
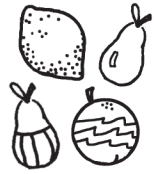
He said to his servant, "Put on the large pot and cook some stew."
